# Adult and Dislocated Worker Needs Related Payment Policy for the Northeast Ohio Consortium Council of Governments Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Policy A-05

## I. Purpose.

The purpose of this policy is to provide the terms and conditions of the provision of formula funded Needs Related Payments ("NRPs") to be provided to eligible adult and dislocated workers. This policy applies to all eligible individuals served with formula funds by the local areas.

#### II. Effective Date.

July 1, 2015.

### III. Background.

NRPs can be used to provide financial assistance to participants for the purpose of enabling individuals to participate in training programs, and are one of the supportive services authorized by section 134 (d)(3) of WIOA. Federal regulations require that payments must be based on financial need.

## IV. Requirements.

It shall be the policy of the Area Workforce to not provide Needs Related Payments. This Policy may be amended at any time by the NOC COG on behalf of the Workforce Board for the Area, or by the Workforce Board, by the implementation of a complete policy that provides for the terms and conditions pursuant to which Needs Related Payments may be provided to eligible adult and dislocated workers.

### V. Monitoring.

The Area Workforce will conduct oversight and monitoring of the implementation of all WIOA programming by all OMJ Center operators, partners, and/or providers pursuant to Area Workforce Policy D-03. Any issues discovered will be handled through the area's monitoring resolution process.

#### VI. Technical Assistance.
