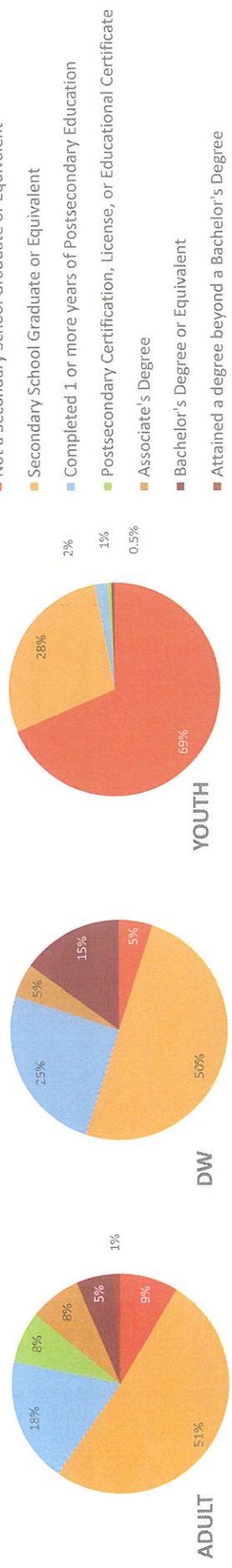

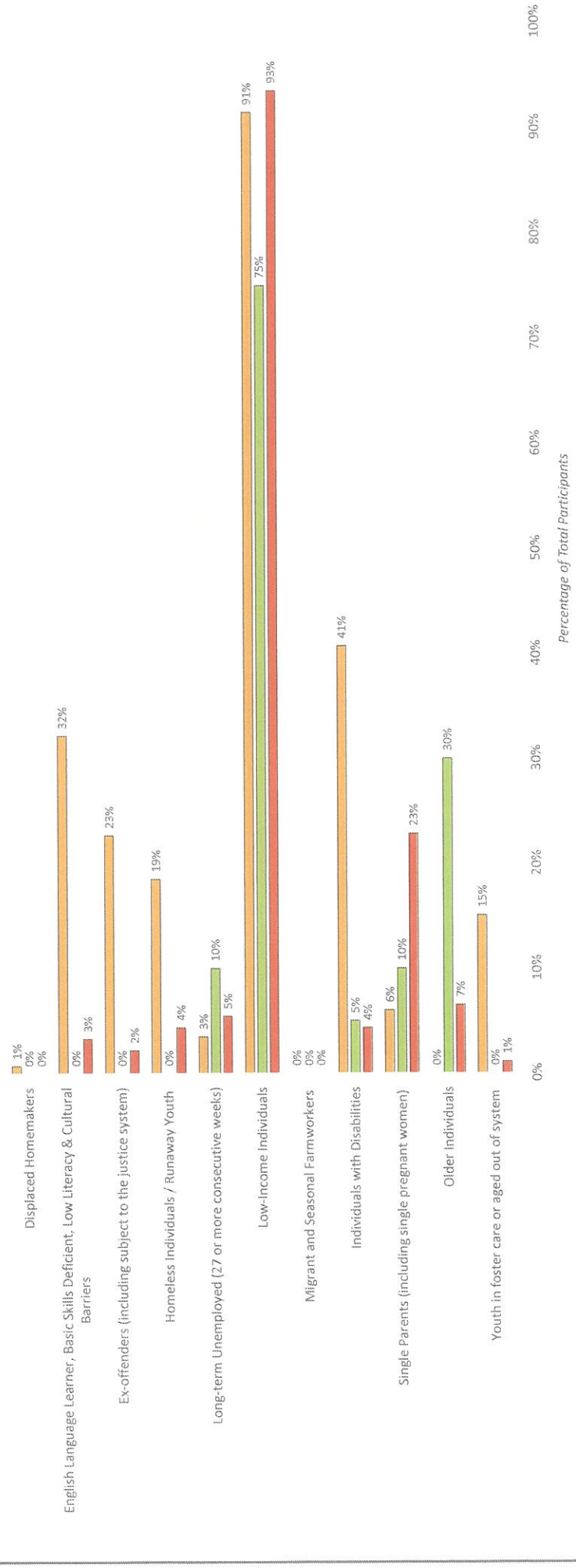

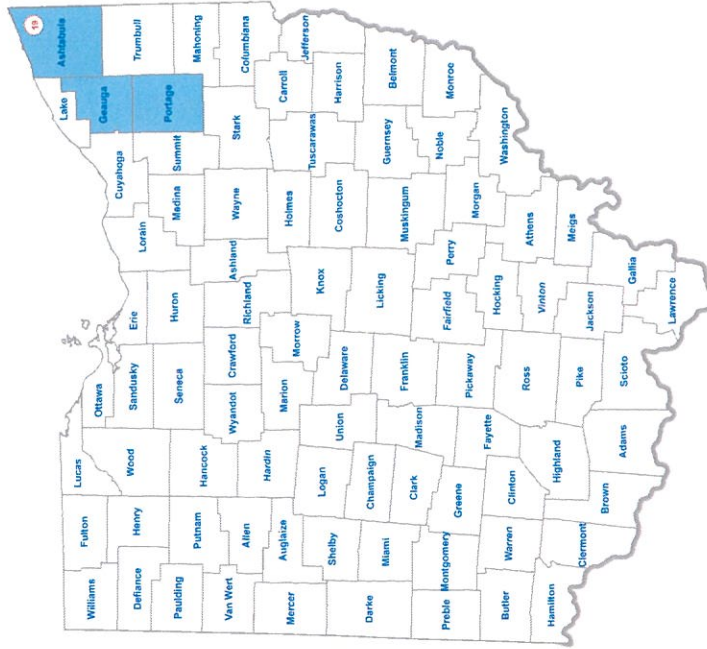
Participant Employment Barrier

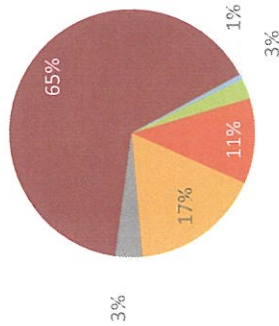

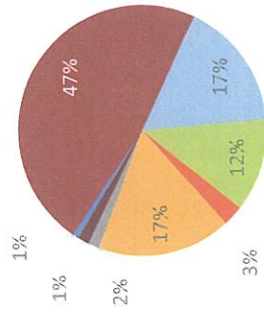

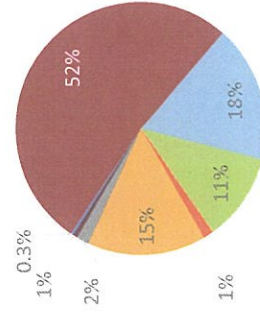

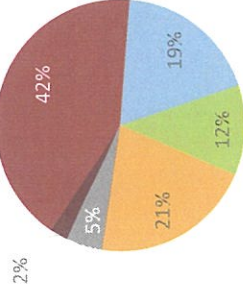
