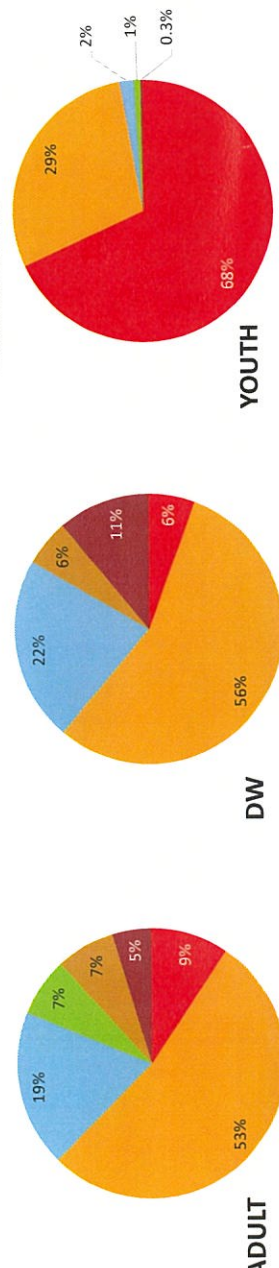

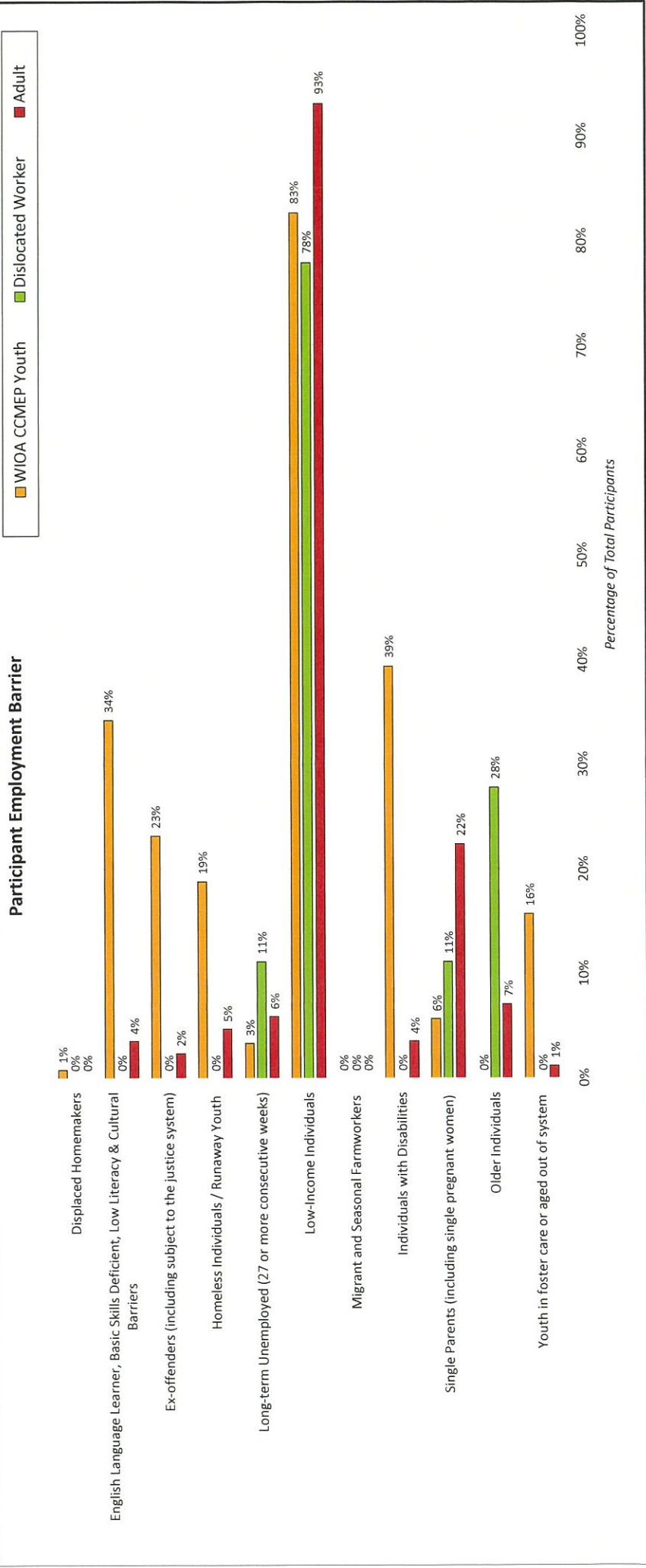

Participant Employment Barrier

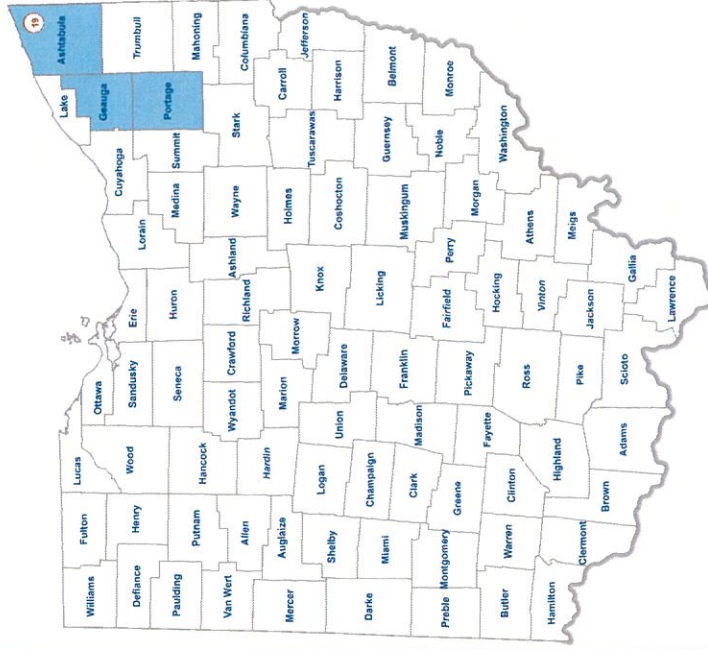

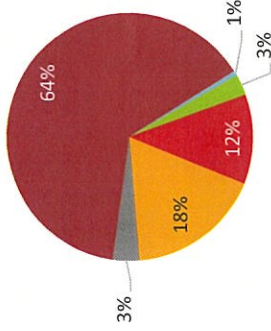

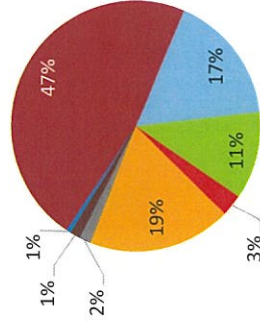

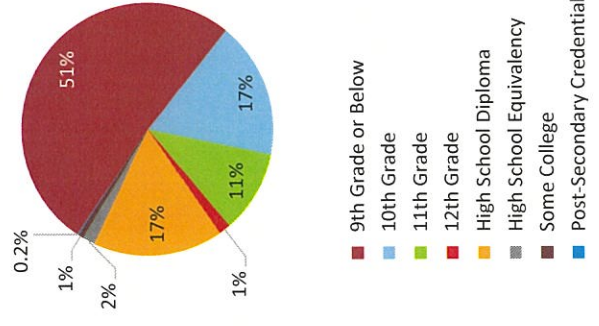

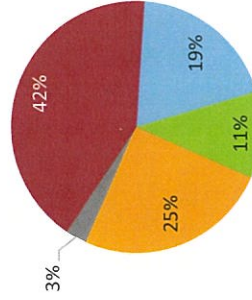

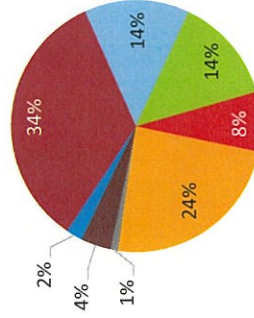
