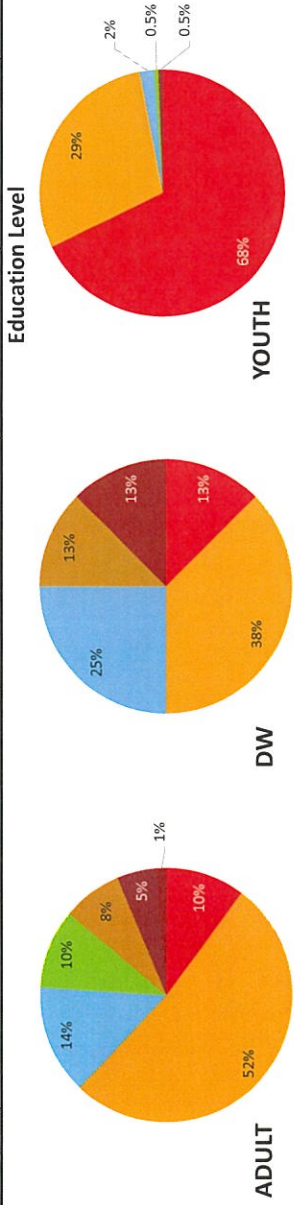

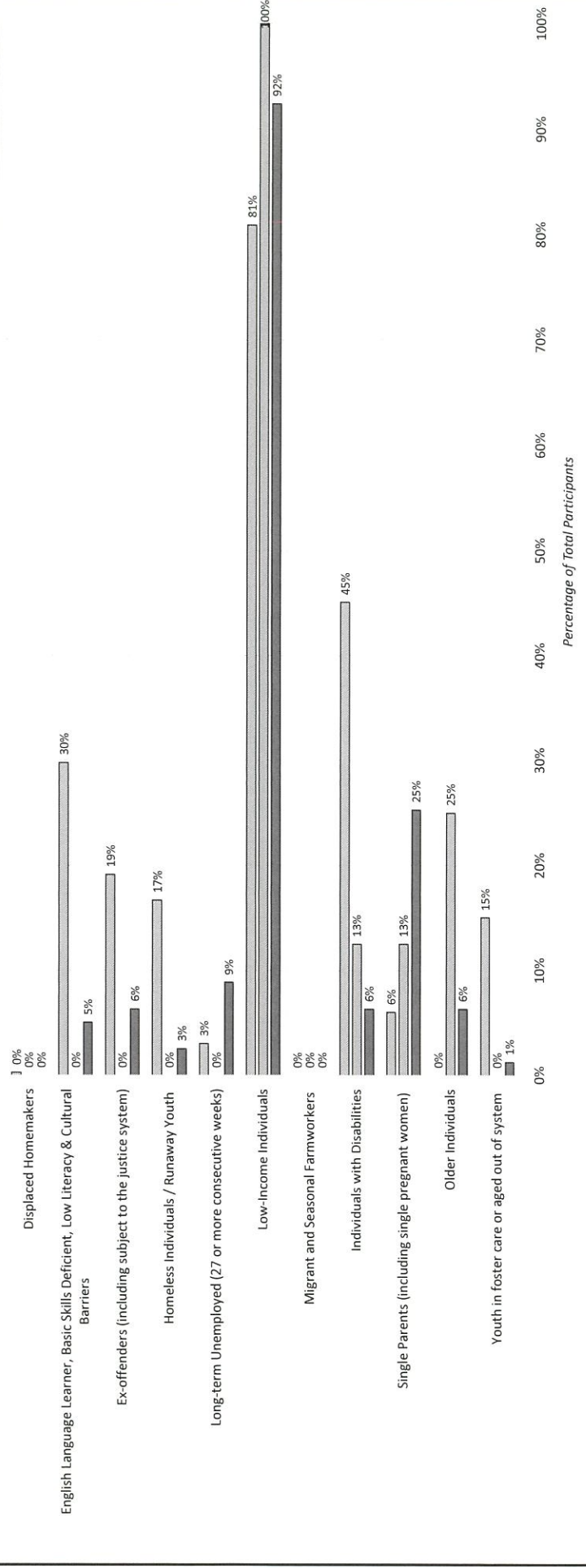

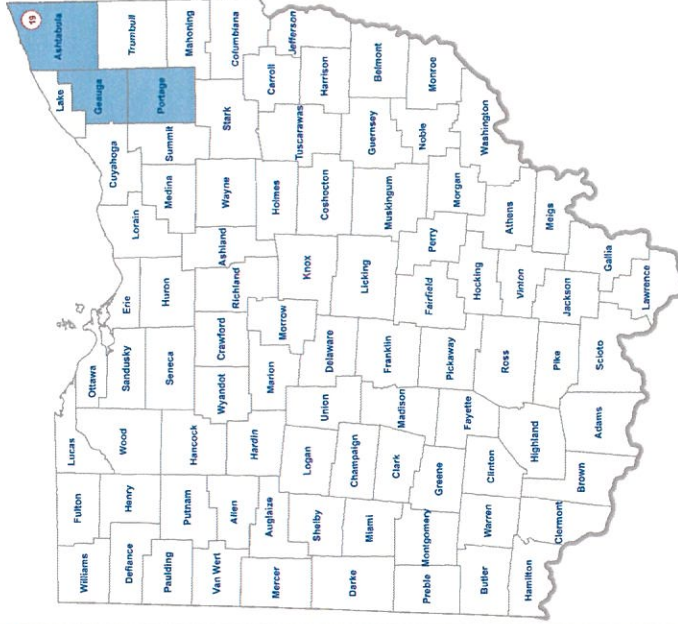
Participant Employment Barrier

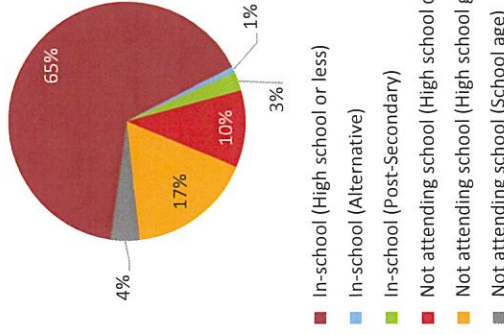

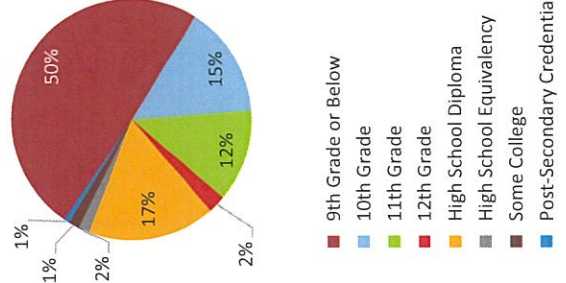

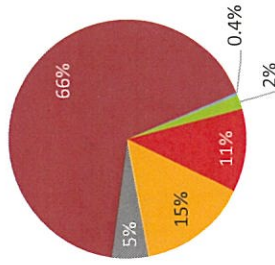

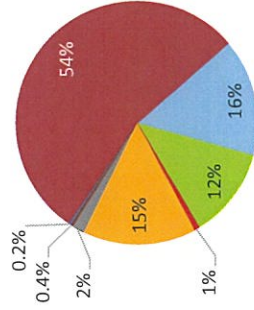

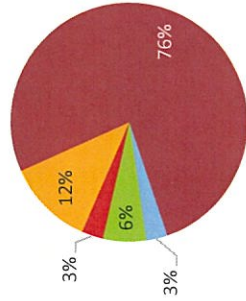

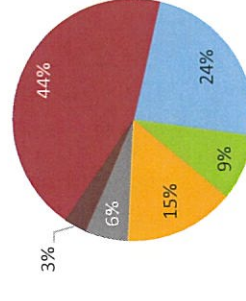
