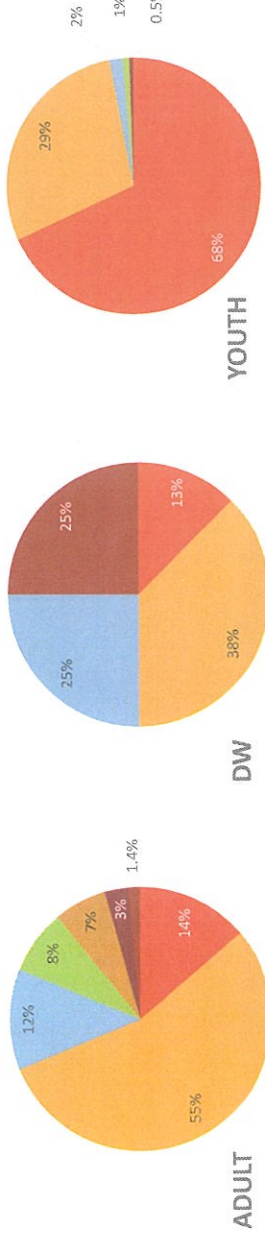

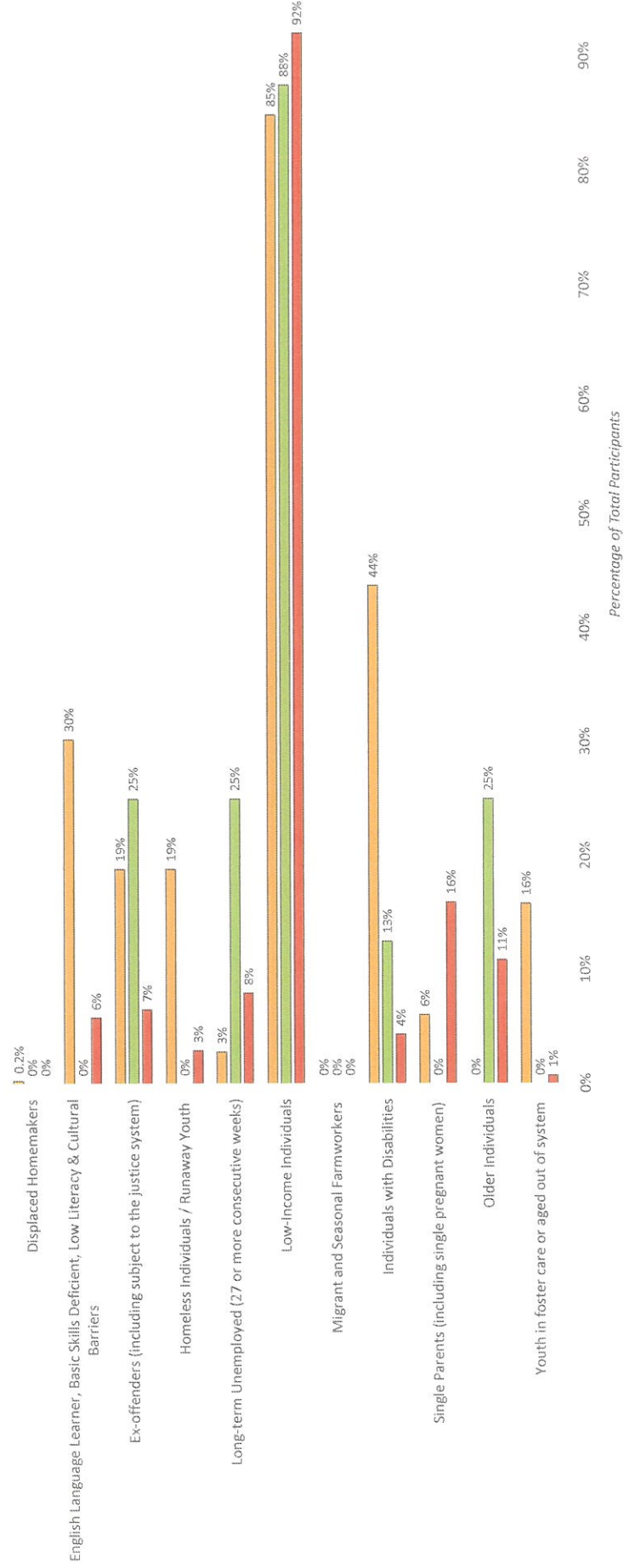

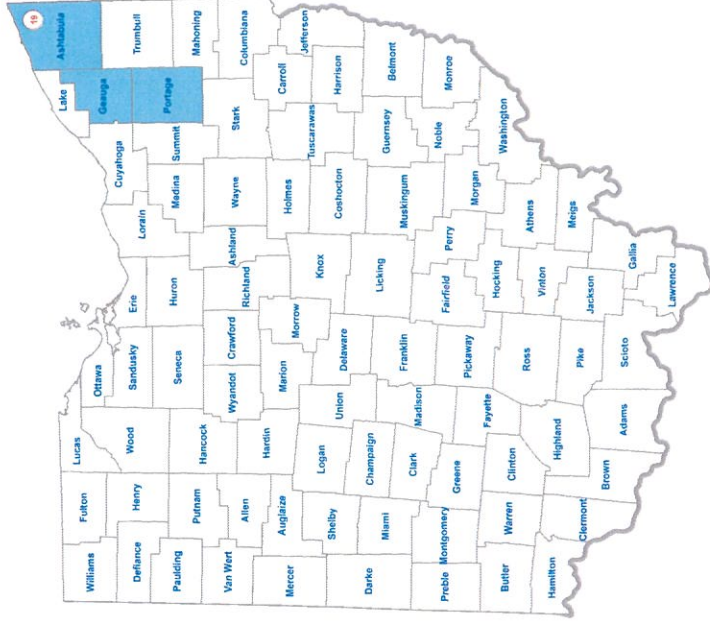
Participant Employment Barrier

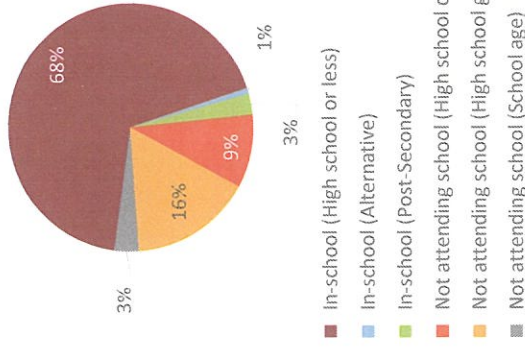

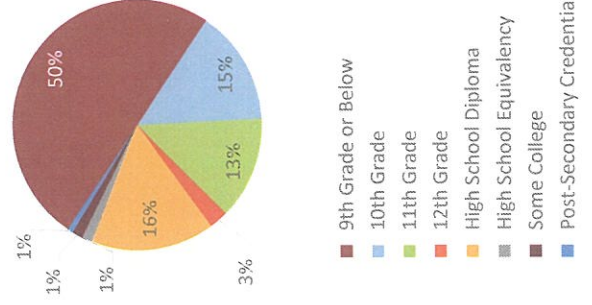

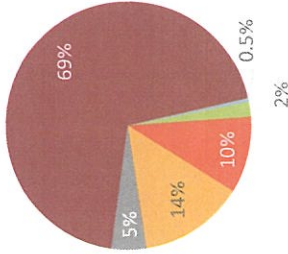

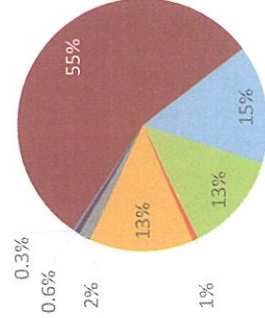

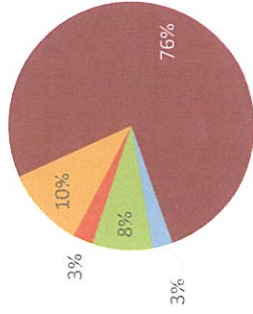

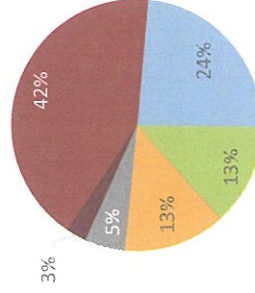

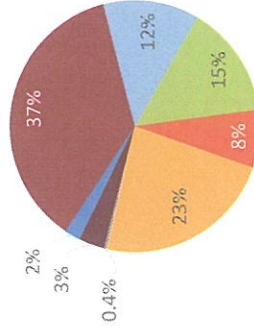
