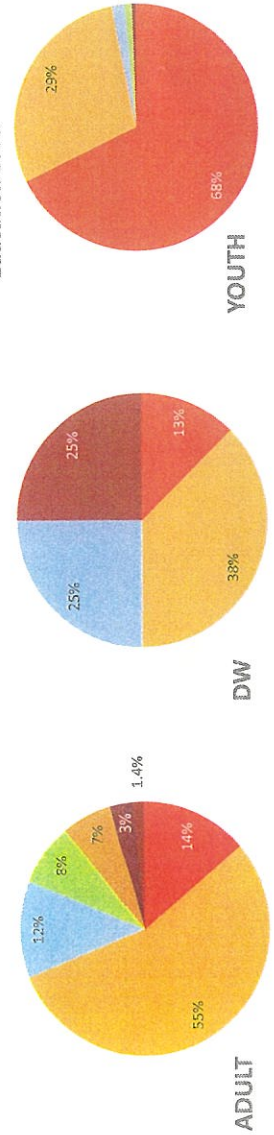

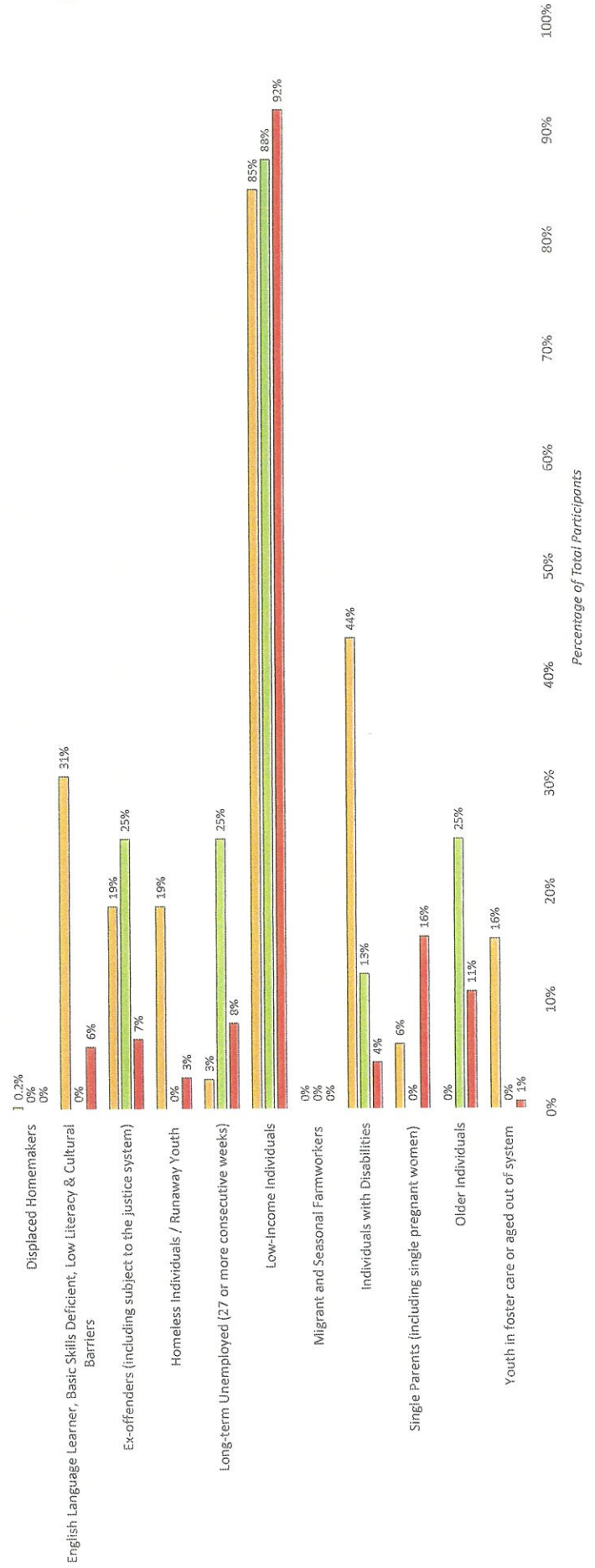

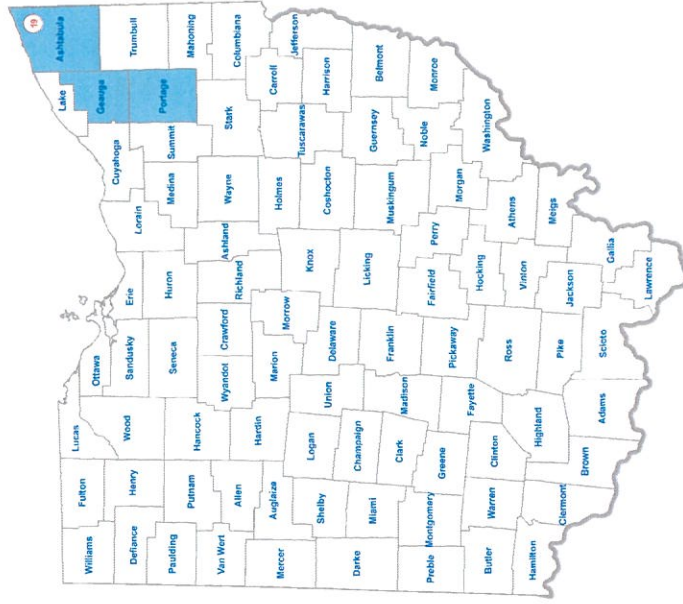
Participant Employment Barrier

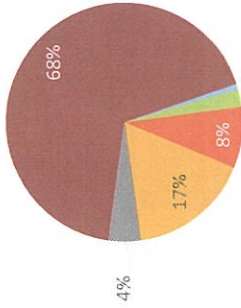

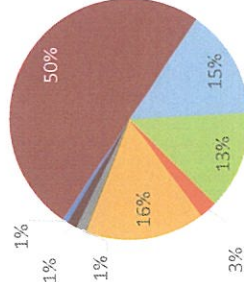

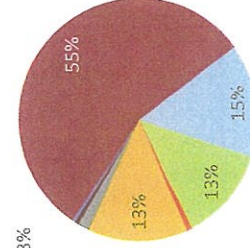

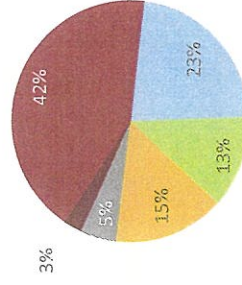

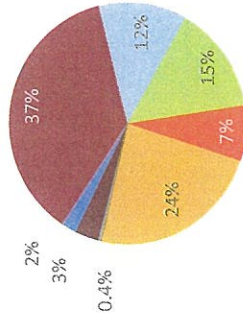
