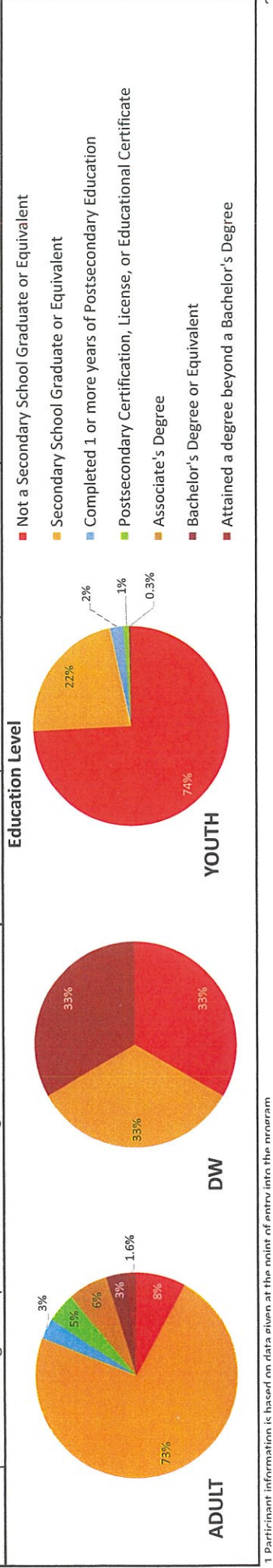

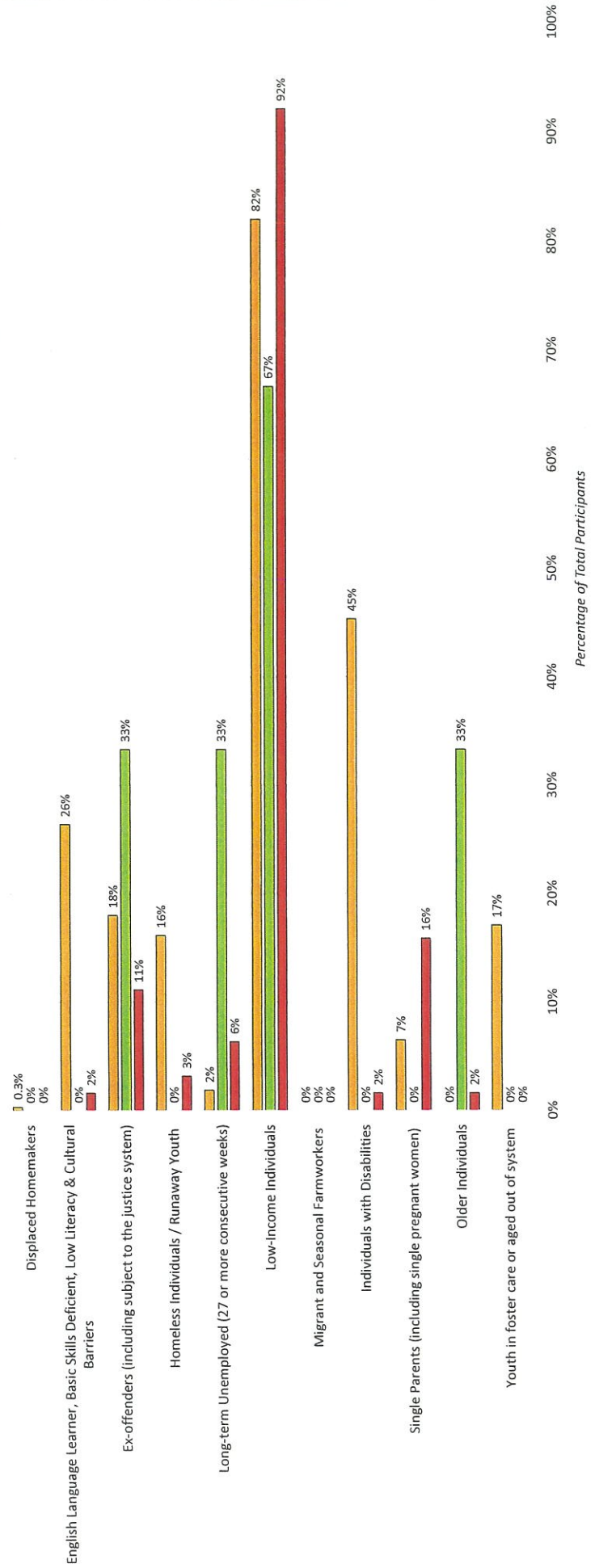

Participant Employment Barrier

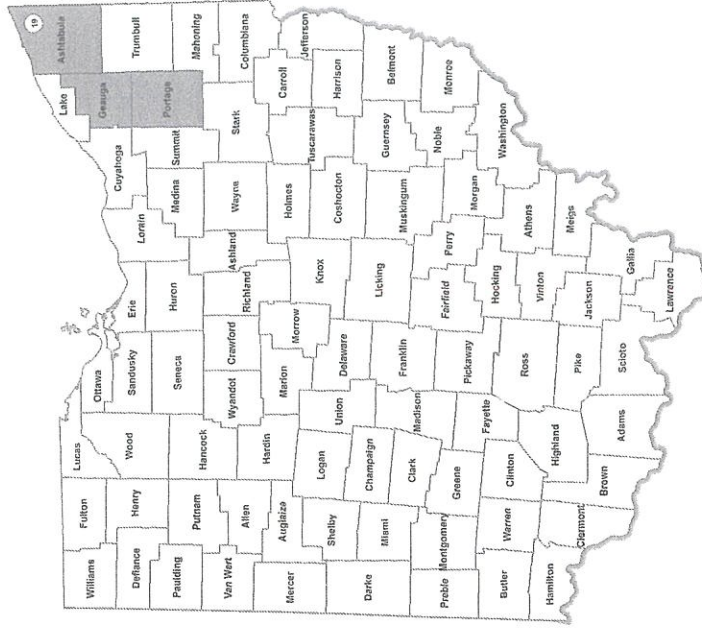

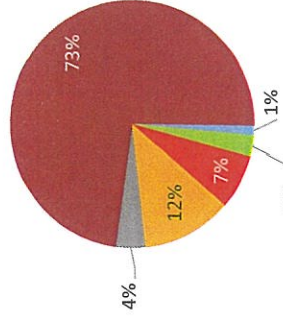

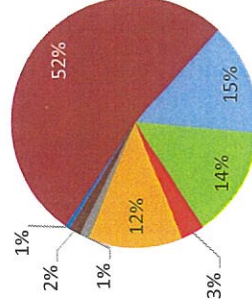

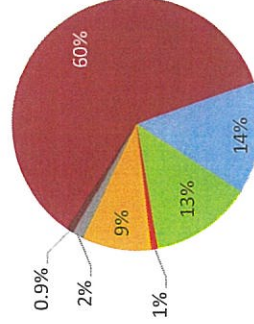

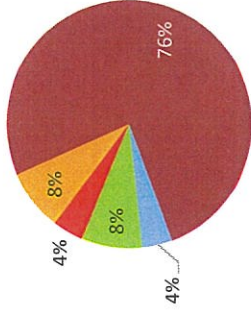

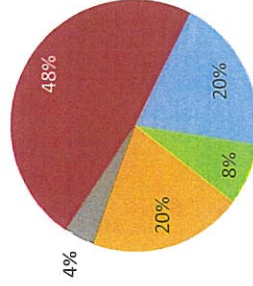

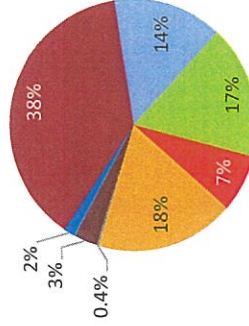
